

Directions to:

**The School of Agriculture, Policy and Development
The University of Reading
Earley Gate
Whiteknights Campus
Reading**

Arrival by car:

Please use the Earley Gate entrance (post code for sat nav purposes: RG6 7BE) for access to the Agriculture building.

The easiest and most direct route is via the M4 motorway.

- Leave the motorway at Junction 11. Please note that there have been recent changes to the road layout at the top of the slip road
- When you reach the roundabout at the top of the slip road follow the signs for the University of Reading
- Follow this road and at the first roundabout turn left on to the A327 (Shinfield Road)
- Follow this road and go straight through two sets of traffic lights, passing a parade of shops and Leighton Park School.
- Turn right at the third traffic light junction into Pepper Lane
- Continue past the Pepper Lane entrance to the University until you reach a roundabout.
- Turn left onto Wilderness Road Follow this road until the third mini-roundabout and turn left into Whiteknights Road.
- The entrance to the University is immediately on your left.
- To reach the Agriculture building (building 59 on the campus map) turn left into the first service road and follow this road (there is a one-way system in operation) to reach car park 22 or car park 23.

Arrival by train:

Trains from Paddington to Reading run approximately every 15 – 20 minutes throughout the day and the average journey time is around 30 minutes.

Bus stops and the taxi rank can be found outside the south exit of the station.

A taxi will cost approximately £8 and will take around 10 minutes. Please ask the taxi driver to take you to the Earley Gate entrance to the campus.

A single bus journey will cost £1.90 (return £3.70). Buses 19a, 19b, and 19c, leaving from stop 'SA' on Station Road, stop at Earley Gate on Whiteknights Road, directly outside the entrance to the University.
